

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES OF AUXILIARY CAPTAINS FOR TWIRLERS AND COLOR GUARDS

1. Assist director/sponsor as well as marching band director with instruction and maintaining general discipline of group.
2. Take responsibility for conducting all rehearsals as previously outlined.
3. Understand any involvement with uniform ordering, cleaning, and inspecting.
4. Demonstrate complete mastery of equipment, routine and drill at all times.
5. Assume all responsibilities of communication between your group and the directors and band staff, the parents of your group members, and the individual members themselves.
6. Know all of the rules, regulations, and policies of the band as outlined in the manual.
7. Be available for outside help and extra practices. You wanted the position of captain, now be willing to sacrifice your time for the betterment of your group.
8. **LEAD BY EXAMPLE:** This is the most important responsibility of any captain. It sets the tone for the actions of the rest of the groups when dealing with punctuality, excused and unexcused absences, always performing to the best of your ability, and showing the value of commitment and sacrifice for the betterment of the group.
